


STORY TIME EVENT & ACTIVITY KIT

Costume Story Time:

Draw your favorite pajamas on Monster!








MAKE YOUR OWN CHRISTMAS TREE!

Glue them to the tree and make your own special tree like Monster!









SWASHBUCKLING COLORING SHEET

Color the eye patch and parrot below in honor of Monster's birthday!








